The course aims to give sufficient knowledge and expertise to enable the holder to play a full role in all aspects of health and safety management within any workplace environment.

The **NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health** is an examined basic qualification for people who have part of their role at work involved in health and safety at work. Such people include newly appointed safety advisers without previous experience, managers and supervisors with part-time responsibility for health and safety, and safety representatives.

NEBOSH Fire Safety and Risk Management

The NEBOSH Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate aims to build on the success of the NEBOSH National General Certificate. It provides an appropriate breadth of underpinning knowledge for non-specialists in fire safety to enable them to discharge more effectively their organisational duties or functions with respect to workplace fire safety.

The **NEBOSH Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate** has been designed for managers, supervisors, employee representatives and others and aims to equip holders to contribute to the conduct and review of fire risk assessments and fire preventive and protective measures within most workplaces.

The Regulatory Reform [Fire Safety] Order 2005 came into effect in 2006 and emphasised the need for management of fire safety risks within the workplace.

To be eligible to attend this 6 day course prospective students must already have attended the NEBOSH National General Certificate or NGC1. To qualify for this Fire Certificate candidates have to pass NGC1[or be exempt from it/have passed it within the last 5 years], FC1 and FC2. The assessment at the end of the course is in two parts. The first part is a practical fire risk assessment hazard identification undertaken in the delegates own workplace. The second part is a two hour examination in which there is one 20 mark question and ten 8 mark questions with all questions being mandatory.

The syllabus will cover:

1. Managing fire safety
2. Principles of fire and explosion
3. Causes and prevention of fire
4. Fire protection in buildings
5. Safety of people in the event of a fire
6. Fire risk assessment

The Construction Certificate has been designed for site managers, planning

supervisors, employee representatives and others who require a basic knowledge and understanding of occupational safety and health as it relates to construction activities. In addition, those working in health and safety in other occupational settings, but who require additional construction-specific knowledge may also benefit from the course or parts of it.

Whereas the syllabus and assessment requirements for the NEBOSH National General Certificate previously formed part of the Construction Certificate, the revised syllabus is now entirely stand-alone. This means that there are no pre-entry requirements for the NEBOSH Construction Certificate, however it is desirable that candidates should have experience of construction methodologies and practices.

The NEBOSH National Certificate in Environmental Management is designed to provide a sound foundation in environmental management knowledge and practice. It is designed for managers, supervisors and employees based in the UK, who have responsibility for managing environment issues as a part of their day-to-day work.

The NEBOSH National Certificate in Environmental Management focuses on UK environmental laws and International management systems, such as ISO 14001. The NEBOSH National Certificate in Environmental Management syllabus covers the practical issues of managing environmental risk, taking a risk management approach based on best practices and international standards, including:

- * Environmental Management Systems and Impact Assessments
- * Sources and use of energy and energy efficiency
- * Control of pollution
- * Planning for and dealing with environmental emergencies

Elements of NEC1:

NEC2, the practical assessment, is set and marked by a suitably qualified assessor, who is appointed by the programme organiser and approved by NEBOSH, to a standard set and moderated by NEBOSH.

NEBOSH Diploma in Environmental Management

Environmental Management is a rapidly developing occupation with an estimated 4,000 plus environmental managers in the UK, and some 500,000 managers working in some form of environmental capacity.

The purpose of the **NEBOSH Diploma in Environmental Management** is to equip people holding an appropriate professional level qualification to undertake responsibilities in relation to the risks of damage to the environment posed by work activities.

Entry Criteria

The programme of study leading to the NEBOSH Diploma in Environmental Management is intended primarily for health and safety practitioners within, or eligible for, the Institution of Occupational Safety & Health (IOSH) grades of Member (MIOSH), Fellow (FIOSH) or Technician Safety Practitioner (TechSP). For those who do not hold IOSH membership at one of these grades entry requires candidates to be able to demonstrate an ability to undertake successfully an intensive programme of study. The applicant should have proven extensive experience of health and safety or hold a sound basic level qualification, such as the NEBOSH National General Certificate but this Centre has discretion to admit candidates without formal qualifications if they be able to show capability to be able to successfully complete the course and would benefit from the course.

Assessment

The system of assessment for the NEBOSH Environmental Diploma includes a practical requirement [project] and examination.

BOHS P405 Management of Asbestos in Buildings

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 (CAR 2006) which came into force in November 2006 put even greater stress on training, asbestos awareness training and asbestos management in the UK.

With property development and expectations on local government and housing associations at an all time high the need for quality and reliable asbestos services from organisations becomes paramount.

This course is accredited by the British Occupational Hygiene Society [BOHS].

Course Objectives

This course is at a proficiency level which aims to provide the student with the practical knowledge and skills to be able to manage asbestos in buildings and give a knowledge base to audit asbestos removal projects. The module is at a proficiency level which aims to provide the candidate with the practical knowledge and skills to be able to manage the stated work being carried out.

CIEH Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS)

This qualification has been developed for anyone entering teaching or training roles or already in-service who needs to achieve the minimum threshold status as a teacher in the lifelong learning sector – that is, adult and community learning and development, further education, libraries, archives and information services and work-based learning.

By 2010, anyone who teaches courses that are publicly-funded will have to be qualified. This qualification introduces the knowledge and skills required by teachers to develop and deliver programmes, provide learning support and take responsibility in managing the learning process in post-16 education.

There are no formal entry requirements for candidates who want to take this qualification; however it is the centre's responsibility to assess, and keep a record, of a candidate's suitability for the programme.

The training programme for the CIEH Level 3 PTLLS includes the CIEH Level 3 Award in Training Skills and Practice (TSP).

This qualification is essential for those who wish to become CIEH registered trainers (certain other training qualifications are also recognised, and conditions regarding technical knowledge and experience also apply).

Course Objectives:

At the conclusion of the programme the expected learning outcomes are that you (the delegate) will:

- Understand your own role, responsibilities and boundaries of role in relation to teaching
- Understand appropriate teaching and learning approaches within a specialist area
- Demonstrate your session planning skills – plan, deliver, observe and evaluate a micro-teaching session
- Understand how to deliver inclusive sessions that motivate learners
- Understand the use of different assessment methods
- Understand and analyse the need for accurate record keeping and procedures that can be adopted – including internal and external assessment information.
